NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS

Dog ownership has many benefits, but with ownership also comes responsibility. The City of Yorkton understands the joys pet ownership can bring. Please ensure that you clean up after your pet.



Please make every effort to observe the following bylaw requirement:

Clean up after your pet:

- If a dog defecates on any public or private property within the City of Yorkton other than the property of its owner, the owner of the animal shall cause the defecation to be removed immediately. This includes all city property (ie. sidewalks, parks, as well as your neighbour's lawn). Please carry a plastic bag at all times when you take your pet for a walk.
- Any person owning a dog and occupying a property in the City of Yorkton shall remove any and all dog defecation from the said property on a daily basis and shall dispose of the defecation in a sanitary manner.

Thank you for being a responsible pet owner.

PARKS BRANCH - PEST CONTROL

The City of Yorkton Parks Branch will begin their weed and pest control program around the City effective immediately.

- Par III will be used for the control of dandelions and broad leaf weeds in turf areas.
- Round-up will be used as it is a non-selective herbicide for the control of weeds in non-turf areas.
- Dipel, a biological insecticide, will be used for the control of the spring cankerworm.

Signs will be posted to ensure public safety prior to application of these pesticides. If you have any questions or concerns, call the Parks office at 786-1780.
