Proposed Bylaw No. 27/2011

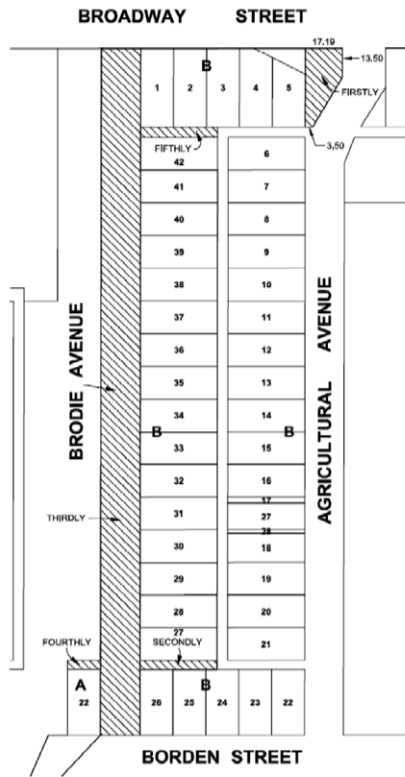
The Council of the City of Yorkton, pursuant to Section 207 of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, hereby gives notice of its intention to pass Bylaw No. 27/2011, to provide for the permanent closure of Brodie Avenue, part of Agricultural Avenue and parts of lanes in Plan No.'s 7023 and 46116. The intent of the closure is to facilitate development of the Brodie Avenue storm water pond and to properly delineate the built roadway at the Agricultural Avenue and Broadway Street intersection.

The proposed Bylaw may be inspected in the office of the Planning and Engineering Department, City Hall by any person without payment of any fees between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., all holidays excepted and up until 12:00 noon on Thursday, November 10, 2011.

Sully Avenue Closed to Traffic

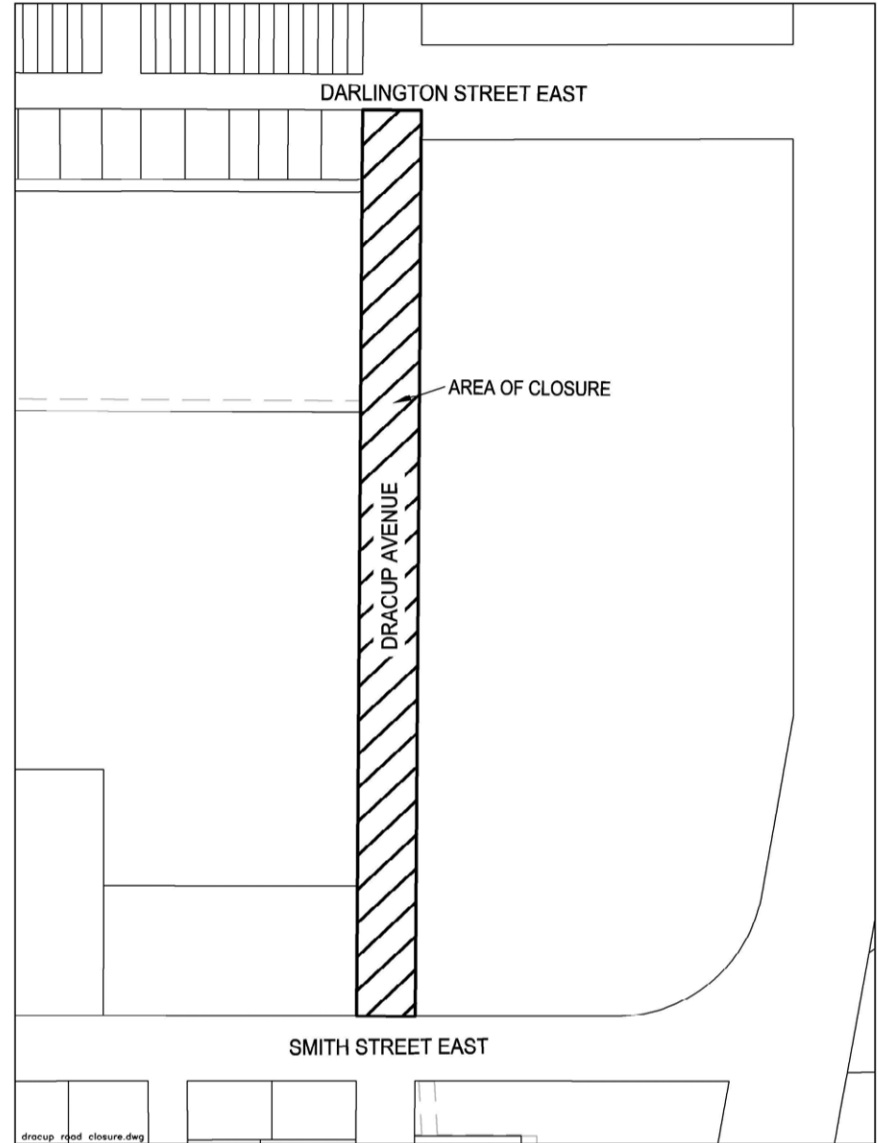

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Private Well Construction and Discharge of Water from Wells

The City of Yorkton would like to inform and remind its residents that bylaws are in place that prohibits the construction of private wells within the City of Yorkton. In addition, the discharge of any well water into any sewer within or entering the City without a permit is also prohibited.

A well can be defined as any underground structure that is dug or drilled into the ground in order to obtain, store or divert water. These structures could present potential issues for drainage to adjacent neighboring properties. They can also be a safety hazard if not properly capped and locked, as well as being a source of contamination of ground water sources.

Bylaw 18/2006, Section 3.27 – Private Wells

3.27 No person shall use any alternate source of water supply other than the City water system without first obtaining the written consent of the City. Private Wells within the City are not permitted.
